A) CALL TO ORDER

The Council for the City of Norwood met in a special session on the above date with Mr. Joseph Geers presiding. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

On roll call, the following members answered present: Mrs. Franzen, Mrs. Hoover, Mrs. Bowling, Ms. Royse, Mrs. Winterbauer, and Mr. Breadon.

D) INTRODUCTORY READING OF ORDINANCES/RESOLUTIONS

1) ORDINANCE APPROVING THE EIGHTH AMENDMENT TO THE DETAILED FINANCIAL PLAN FOR THE CITY OF NORWOOD, AND DECALRING AN EMERGENCY.

On a motion by Mr. Breadon, seconded by Mrs. Winterbauer, it was moved to suspend the rules and have all three readings of the ordinance.

Mr. Breadon asked what changes had been made to the document since the day before. Mayor Schneider replied that certain salary amounts were updated to reflect the accurate amount, as well as descriptions of part time vs. full time statuses of certain positions.

Mrs. Winterbauer asked Mr. Bonsall how accurate the forecasted budgets have been in the past. Mr. Bonsall stated that last year's forecast was exceeded by one million dollars. He stated there is variability in large part because net profit tax collected from business can fluctuate greatly from year to year. He stated that Factory 52 tenants have resulted in some income, but most are smaller operations. He predicted that what will bring more money into the city is any future office space at Factory 52.

Mayor Schneider commended the efficiency of the Tax Department.

Mrs. Hoover asked if the budget reflects expenses related to new fire trucks and police vehicles. Mayor Schneider confirmed that it does.

All members present voted, "Yes."

On a motion by Mrs. Winterbauer, seconded by Mrs. Franzen, it was moved to pass the ordinance.

All members present voted "Yes." The motion passed.

E) EXCUSE ABSENT MEMBER/S

On a motion by Mr. Breadon, seconded by Mrs. Franzen, it was moved to excuse the absent member. All members present voted "Yes." The motion passed.
